Chili Cook-off for the 300th Sept. 24

As part of Nottingham's 300th yearlong anniversary celebration, the Nottingham Fire & Rescue Department Association (NFRDA) is having Chili Cook-off Contest on Saturday, September 24, 2022, at 12 PM noon at the Fire Station, 235 Stage Road. It will feature three entry categories and three cash prizes for each one. It is in the tradition of the tasty [Blueberry Bake-Off Contest](#) held there on July 24, 2022, which was a huge success.

Here are the rules. All entries must be delivered to the Fire Station exactly and only between 11-11:30 AM that Saturday. The official rule states **Entry with recipes shall be at Nottingham Fire Station between 11:00 am - 11:30 am on Saturday, September 24, 2022 (NO EARLY OR LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED)!** The 3 entry categories are Red (all red meats- beef, venison, bison, etc), White (all white meats - chicken, turkey, pork, etc) and vegetarian, (containing no meat). And there will be cash prizes for each category. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes awarded per category (\$25, \$15, \$10 cash, prize ribbons, and bragging rights!)

Although the contestants will prepare the entries, only NFRDA members will actually present the entry to the judges. This allows the judges to only see and sample the entry without being influenced by seeing and hearing from the smiling cook. One of the judges will be Nate Varney, a professional chef. Participants shall bring one FULL crockpot or Dutch oven for judging (the remainder will be offered to the general public for consumption as an NFRDA fundraiser).

All chili entries must remain on site until the end of the event. 8. Nottingham Fire along with contest judges reserve the right to disqualify an entry if criteria are not met and rules are not followed.
