Hazardous Waste Collection Day Sept. 24

Nottingham will have its annual [household hazardous waste collection day](#) on Saturday, September October 3, 2022, from 8:00 a.m. to 12 Noon at the end of Industrial Drive, off Old Manchester Road (exit 4) across from the Safety Complex in Raymond NH. This is traditionally conducted in the Fall and is only for residents of Auburn, Nottingham, and Raymond. Each car is limited to bringing a maximum quantity per household item of either 5 gallons or 5 pounds depending on which is higher. There are certain items that will not be accepted. These are motor oil, latex paint, ammunition, fire extinguishers, and medical waste. But what you can bring are oil-based paint, pesticides, fertilizer, brake fluid, and pool chemicals.
