### **Official Chowder Cookoff Rules and Details!**

\*ABSOLUTELY NO APPLICATIONS AFTER DEADLINE (October 28th, 2022) \*

#### **Rules:**

1. Entry with recipes shall be at Nottingham Fire Station between 11:00 am - 11:30 am on Saturday, October 29th, 2022 (NO EARLY OR LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED)
2. Participants are allowed to make 1 entry per category. (You may not compete against yourself)
3. Categories are Seafood Chowder and Non-Seafood Chowder
4. 1st, 2nd, and 3rd prizes shall be awarded per category (\$25, \$15, \$10 cash, prize ribbons, and bragging rights!)
5. Participants prepare a presentation for judges, but the NFRD Association will present the dishes to the judges anonymously.
6. Participants shall bring one FULL crockpot for judging (the remainder will be offered to the general public for consumption as a NFRDA fundraiser)
7. All chowder entries must remain on site until the end of the event
8. Nottingham Fire along with contest judges reserve the right to disqualify an entry if criteria is not met and rules are not followed.

#### **And!!**

- \*Free raffles for all those who have entries.
- \*Samples and tastings will be available throughout the event.
- \*Power strips will be available for use. As well as an oven and microwave for heating purpose ONLY.
- \*NO food shall be prepared on site.
