### Getting Power to Marston

On Monday April 18, 2022 the conduit pvc pipes for the electrical connections to the utility shed at Marston Farm Recreational Area were done. It was a volunteer effort which was supervised by Carl Edin and the work was performed by Wakita Electric out of Shapleigh, Maine. These pipes to the utility shed were to both sides of the structure, On the north side they connect to the concrete vault donated partially by [Shea Concrete](#). The vault itself will house the transformer. On the south side the connection will provide power to the future scoreboards. After this work has been inspected, the electrical company will set the transformer and thread the wires through the vault and pipes. The utility shed will also contain a water tank used for public water access and controls to irrigate the athletic fields. Soon also, side fencing will be installed.
